RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. *Term time:*
Normal school terms, but the school will be closed for Jewish Festivals. Precise dates are given in the School Calendar.
2. *Hours:*
Morning sessions: 9:00 am to 12:00 pm or 12.15pm, 9.15 am to 12.30 pm Monday to Friday
Breakfast Club: 8.00 am to beginning of morning session (Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays).
Lunch Club: 12.00 pm – 2.00 pm or 2.15pm 12.15 pm – 2.30 pm (Monday to Thursday)
3. *Age range:*
From 2 years at commencement of term until entry to primary school.
4. *Activities:*
We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. The school year is based on the Jewish Festivals with a flexible programme designed to interest, stimulate and develop all aspects of a child's personality.
5. *Current Fees (from Sept 2010):*
For 5 mornings: **£960** per term.
A proportion is covered by the Government's nursery grant scheme for children over 3 years old.
Younger class: For 2 mornings: **£47** per week.
For 3 mornings: **£66** per week.
(Please note that higher fees are charged for the younger children as Ofsted require a greater staff:pupil ratio for this age group.)
Breakfast Club **£8.50** per session
Lunch club for older children: **£15.00** per session.
Afternoon sessions for 2 year olds: **£19.00** per session.

Fees are payable on or before the first day of term and are reviewed each September.
A deposit of **£200** is payable on acceptance of the place offer.
6. ****One term's notice of intention to withdraw a child from School is required in writing, or a term's fees in lieu of notice will be payable****.
7. Milk is provided, and only fruit may be brought onto the premises.
8. All clothes and personal belongings should be indelibly marked with the child's name.
9. Boys are required to wear kippot and tzitzit at School. These will be provided by the School at a nominal charge.
10. ****PLEASE NOTE that all parents are required to pay a security fee per term per family and to participate in the security rota and must observe the rules regarding the setting down and collecting of children****.
£115 per term for 5 mornings
£70 per term for 3 mornings or 3 afternoons
£51 per term for 2 mornings or 2 afternoons
11. It is at the sole discretion of the Board of Governors to refuse an application, or to request the suspension or removal of any child from the Nursery School.
